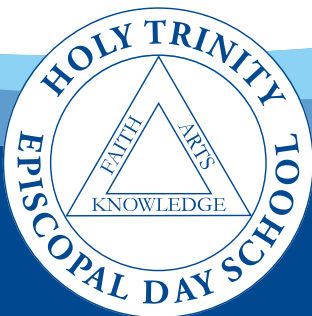

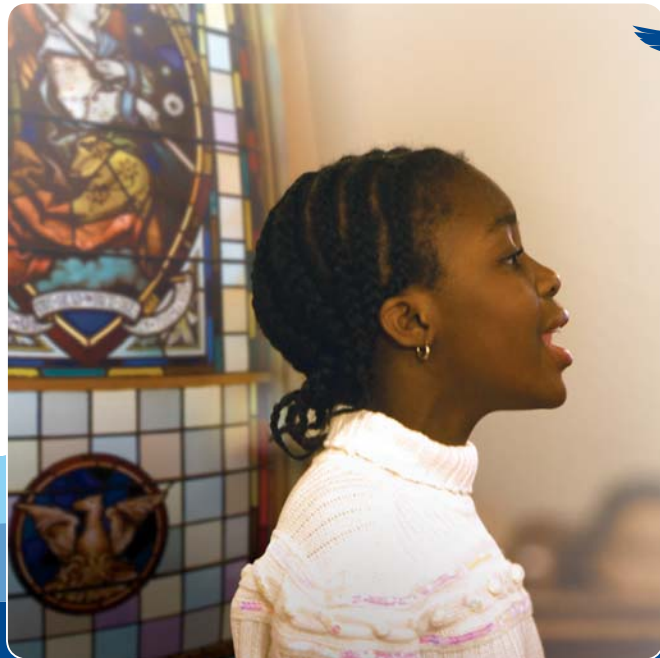




Holy Trinity Episcopal Day School

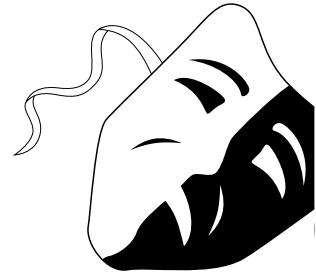

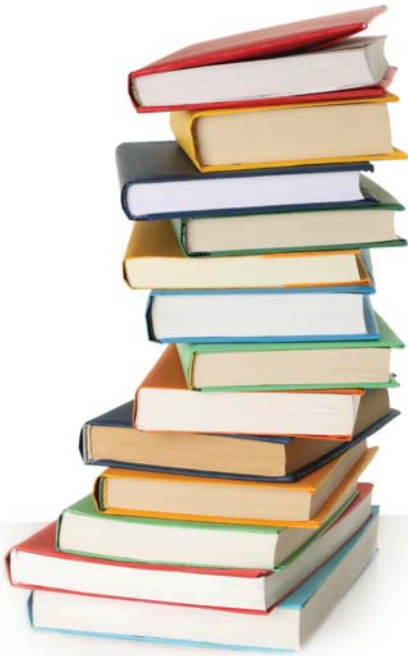
